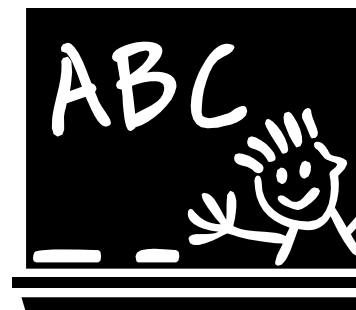

Panther Premier Sessions:

Middle School Experience- All students will participate in "Middle School Experience" during the first session of the day. The purpose of the class is to familiarize students with the Pinckneyville campus and lessen anxiety about attending middle school. Students will practice opening and using lockers and have scavenger hunts to learn their way around campus.

Study and Social Skills- All students will participate during the last session of the day. Class activities will address cooperation, communication, leadership skills, and how they will help you rise to the top of the sixth grade! All learning experiences are supported and enhanced by effectively incorporating good study habits and organizational skills. This program is designed to teach students how to develop these skills in order to maximize each child's learning potential.

Reading:
Reading Workshop- Students will get a head start completing one of their summer book reports. One novel will be chosen by the instructor. Students will spend the class period reading and engaging in activities related to the novel.

Reading in the Content Areas- One of the most difficult tasks for a student is learning to read challenging, unfamiliar and time consuming material in the content areas (science, social studies, language arts, and math). This program will provide students with specific ideas and techniques for improving student reading, handling vocabulary, and finding important information within their content area texts.

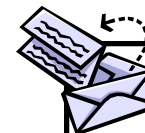
